
## **Third Generation:**

**1. ELIAS CASWELL JORDAN** was born in Montgomery County on 4 February 1858, the son of Miles and Martha (Williams) Jordan.<sup>1</sup> He died in Albemarle on 26 July 1939 and is buried in Fairview Memorial Park in Albemarle.<sup>2</sup> Elias Jordan grew to manhood during the Civil War and its aftermath. As part of a large family living on a farm, he would have helped in the farming chores. When he was 21 he was living next to his parents and farming, but by 1900 he had moved to Albemarle in Stanly Co., and was working in the cotton mill, which he would continue to do well into his 70s.<sup>3</sup>

In 1912, even though Elias Jordan was living in Stanly County, he bought land in Troy township, Montgomery County, "lots 9 and 11 of Section B of the Jerry Russell tract."<sup>4</sup> The plat map for this deed is in an early deed book.<sup>5</sup>



The children of Elias and Mary (Mask) Jordan, all born in Montgomery Co., were as follows:

i. ADA B. JORDAN, born in Montgomery County on 20 January 1885 and died in Albemarle on 21 April 1975.<sup>7</sup> She is buried in Palestine Methodist Church Cemetery in Albemarle.<sup>8</sup> She married, first, John Wesley Hall in Stanly County on 22 April 1906.<sup>9</sup> He was born there on 19 August 1880, the son of Doc F. and Nycia (Morris) Hall, and died in Harris, Stanly County on 25 February 1933.<sup>10</sup> Ada (Jordan) Hall married, second, Green A. Almond in Stanly County on 27 July 1935.<sup>11</sup> He was born 9 August 1877, the son of Green and Julia (Whitley) Almond, and died in Harris on 28 June 1958.<sup>12</sup> He is buried in Fairview Memorial Park in Albemarle.<sup>13</sup>

ii. BERTHA LEE JORDAN was born 14 May 1886 and died in Albemarle on 1 March 1937; she is buried in Fairview Cemetery, Albemarle.<sup>14</sup> She married William Eugene Austin in Stanly County on 23 December 1904.<sup>15</sup> He was born 13 April 1876, the son of W. Preston and Mary Elizabeth (Pickler) Austin and died in Salisbury on 1 May 1964.<sup>16</sup> He is also buried in Fairview Memorial Park in Albemarle.<sup>17</sup>

iii. JOHN MILES JORDAN was born 26 November 1888 and died in Goldhill on 18 August 1975; he is buried in Poplin Grove Cemetery in Albemarle.<sup>18</sup> He married Eliza Jane Smith in Albemarle on 15 November 1908.<sup>19</sup> She was born 8 August 1889, the daughter of Andrew Webster and Patty (Hudson) Smith and died 24 May 1979; she is also buried in Poplin Grove Cemetery.<sup>20</sup>

v. MARY F. JORDAN was born 16 February 1892 and died in Raleigh on 2 August 1965; she is buried in Fairview Memorial Park in Albemarle.<sup>21</sup> She married John Calvin Austin in Stanly County on 7 February 1912.<sup>22</sup> He was born 30

November 1886, the son of W. Preston and Mary Elizabeth (Pickler) Austin and died in Albemarle on 20 November 1972.<sup>23</sup> He is also buried in Fairview Memorial Park.<sup>24</sup>

vi. LAURA E. JORDAN was born 28 January 1894 and died in Winston-Salem, N.C. on 11 November 1976.<sup>25</sup> She is buried in Greenlawn Cemetery in China Grove.<sup>26</sup> She married James Claude Pinion in Stanly County on 8 November 1914.<sup>27</sup> He was born 28 May 1895, the son of James Franklin and Lucy (Killis) Pinion and died in China Grove on 24 May 1970.<sup>28</sup> He is also buried in Greenlawn Cemetery.<sup>29</sup>

vii. JAMES ROPER JORDAN was born 19 May 1896 and died in Stanly County on 11 February 1995.<sup>30</sup> He is buried in Palestine Methodist Church Cemetery in Albemarle.<sup>31</sup> He married Laura Elizabeth Harris in Stanly County on 24 December 1915.<sup>32</sup> She was born 21 December 1890, the daughter of William Lee and Julie (Dry) Harris and died in Albemarle on 16 September 1975.<sup>33</sup> She is also buried in Palestine Methodist Church Cemetery in Albemarle.<sup>34</sup> viii. WALTER CLAY JORDAN was born in Stanly County on 20 February 1899, died in Norwood on 18 July 1968, and buried in Silver Springs Baptist Church Cemetery in Norwood.<sup>35</sup> He married Altha Estelle Kimrey in Albemarle on 15 June 1921.<sup>36</sup> She was born in Stanly County on 30 October 1898, the daughter of Wilbert and Louise (Foreman) Kimrey, and died in Norwood on 17 October 1979; she is also buried in Silver Springs Baptist Church Cemetery.<sup>37</sup>

ix. MARGIE ANNABELL JORDAN was born 2 August 1902 and died in Concord on 28 January 1921.<sup>38</sup> She is buried in Fairview Memorial Park in Albemarle.<sup>39</sup> She married James Edward Berry in Stanly County on 7 March 1920.<sup>40</sup> He was born 7 November 1896, the son of Sidney E. and Laura Delia (Potts) Berry and died 26 July 1962 in Walnut Cove; he is buried in Carolina Memorial Park in Concord.<sup>41</sup>

2. MARY ANN MASK was born in Montgomery County on 19 September 1862, the daughter of John Mask and Julia Stacy and died in Albemarle on 2 March 1934; she is buried in Fairview Memorial Park, Albemarle.<sup>42</sup> Mary Ann Mask was the second child and oldest daughter of John Mask and his wife Julia (Stacy) Mask. Mary Ann (Mask) Jordan was mentioned as a legatee in her father's will, written in 1908.<sup>43</sup> She and her husband were the recipients of 60 acres of land near Mount Gilead from her father, deeded to her from her siblings in 1909.<sup>44</sup> The early 1920s were a difficult time: between December 1919 and January 1921 Mary and Elias Jordan lost a daughter-in-law (Hallie Walters Jordan, age 24) and their youngest daughter (Margie Jordan Berry, age 18), leaving five grandchildren without a mother.
